I am an Oregon voter and I support HB3075-1. Please pass HB 3075-1 out of committee without delay so it is ready, as soon as the court's stay is lifted, for full implementation of Measure 114. We passed Measure 114 to reduce gun violence. It's time to begin saving lives.

I am a retired rural veterinarian. I packed a 12 G shotgun in the veterinary truck to use for humane anesthesia, and kept other firearms in my house for varmint control. As a Christian, I am aghast at the ever increasing gun violence in our city, state, country, and world. This is much more apparent in the city, where hardly a day goes by without someone being gunned down for no legal or moral reason.
