Thank you for your time today:

1. The proposed fee of \$160 of a permit, negatively impacts myself as I am a senior citizen in the lower socioeconomic category. Being on a limited SSI income, I will never be able to afford the the cost of the training required to be able to purchase a permit which on top of training would be an additional \$160.00.
2. As a senior citizen that lives rurally alone, the financial impact of this measure will leave me unable to protect myself. I reside in the northern edge of our count, leaving myself with unknown response times from county law enforcement.
3. Making this challenge able only in Marion County, puts an undo hardship upon many Oregon residents. Myself, the limited income hinders my ability to travel to Salem with the price of gasoline. It also makes it almost impossible for those that reside in Eastern Oregon.
4. EX POST FACTO...”a criminal statute that punishes actions, retroactively thereby criminalizing conduct that was legal when originally preformed”, hence making many legal firearm owners criminals.
