Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

I oppose this bill and urge the committee to oppose it as well.

Any restrictions on the ability of peaceable people to obtain firearms and standard firearms components (magazines holding greater than 10 rounds), are wrong.

This bill creates financial and procedural barriers for peaceable people to own firearms. Rather than making the community safer, those intent on doing evil will continue to do so, undeterred by this law, or any other.
