I oppose HB307.

This bill will make life harder for minority groups and poor people. Studies show that in other states with similar laws, people of color are more likely to be denied certain rights than white people. I am concerned that giving police more power during a time when many people fear the government could hurt communities that are already struggling.

The laws would raise fees for which makes it tougher for disadvantaged people with less money to protect themselves. In addition, Oregon has not even figured out how to provide enough training statewide for everyone who would need it.

If signed into law this bill would punish people for things they did in the past, which goes against the U.S. and Oregon Constitutions.

Measure 114 has not worked its way through the justice system and this bill may be short lived causing harm to Oregon citizens.

This bill will not have any impact on gun violence in the state. What it will do is make it more difficult for law abiding citizens to access firearms which is a constitutional right.
