I also oppose the following items in HB 3075:

The ex post facto provision of HB 3075 is truly atrocious. I am referring to the part that would make criminals of any Oregon residents that purchased firearm magazines of greater than 10 rounds prior to actual passing of the law. Whoever wrote that truly wants to harm law abiding gun owners. There is no justification whatsoever for that. And the affirmative defense provision makes it virtually impossible to prove when specific magazines were purchased since, even if the owner kept receipts, there are no serial numbers on magazines to prove that those specific magazines were the ones purchased with the receipt.

Also, the provision to require legal challenges to be filed only in Marion county is a blatantly despotic provision to disenfranchise the legal rights of people that don't live close to Marion country.
