The majority of the lodging tax generated in Crook County already goes to the County's general fund, which supports many other services, including public safety. At the City level, funding would be redirected toward non-tourism services, eliminating the ability to support and grow tourism in our city and county. With the passing of HB 3556, a growing economic driver for our region would be at risk, impacting local jobs and businesses across the region and within our communities.
