Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

Dear Members of the Committee,
I strongly oppose HB 3075 for the following reasons:

1. Constitutional violations: This bill infringes on my Second Amendment rights by imposing unreasonable restrictions on firearm ownership.
2. Unnecessary: Thorough background check including fingerprinting are already required by Oregon law
3. Retroactive criminalization: The bill unfairly targets law-abiding citizens who legally purchased standard capacity magazines before the ban, potentially making them criminals overnight.
4. Excessive government control: The bill grants too much power to the state over firearm ownership and transfers, undermining individual liberties.
5. Undue burden: Doubling fees and waiting periods creates an unnecessary obstacle for responsible gun owners. Requiring a class by LEO's that will be absurd and unneeded is also concerning.

I urge you to reject HB 3075
