HB 4004 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Provides that additional taxes otherwise imposed upon disqualification of land from certain forestland special assessment programs may not be collected if the disqualification is due to the suspension of reforestation requirements as a result of insects or disease.

Please note: HB 4153 is scheduled solely for the purpose of hearing testimony from the people who previously signed up to testify at the meeting on 2/4/2026.

HB 4153

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/4/2026 MEETING: Allows counties to approve farm stores, instead of farm stands, as nonfarm use on lands zoned for farm use.

HB 4065

Modifies provisions relating to late payment of seed production contracts and seed purchase contracts for agricultural seed and other seed.

HB 4105 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Forester to determine the available state forestland, establish sustainable harvest levels for harvesting timber on state forestland and manage available state forestland.

HB 4006

Authorizes holders of certain Columbia River water rights to change the point of diversion or use the water right on land to which the right is not appurtenant, provided certain conditions are met.
