HB 4144 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/10/2026 MEETING: Requires producers of batteries or battery-containing products to join a battery producer responsibility organization and implement a battery producer responsibility program for the collection and recycling of batteries.

HB 4077

Authorizes a public utility, upon approval by the Public Utility Commission, to issue bonds and securitize debt for costs and expenses incurred or to be incurred by the public utility associated with a self-insurance or captive insurance program.

HB 4046 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Department of Energy, subject to the availability of funding, to conduct a study on nuclear energy, including advanced nuclear reactors.

HB 4030

Exempts packaging for certain berries and meat, poultry, fish and seafood from producer responsibility requirements for packaging, paper and food serviceware.

HB 4060

Exempts sales to purchasers with facilities totaling more than one million square feet from a prohibition on sales of certain fluorescent lamps until January 1, 2030.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4076

Requires the State Department of Energy to study energy.
