Celebrates the 75th anniversary of the Oregon Fire District Directors Association.

Work Session

HB 4032 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Department of Energy to evaluate and prioritize geographically dispersed emergency fuel storage sites.

HB 4033 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Transfers responsibility for the volunteer database known as ORVID from the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management.

HB 4044 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates the Office of Resilience and Emergency Management within the Department of Human Services.

HB 4091

Allows the Adjutant General to facilitate, assist or coordinate in the mobilization of the Oregon National Guard under Title 10 of the United States Code or Title 32 of the United States Code under an authority other than the Governor, only if the active service is for certain listed reasons.

HB 4100

Requires owners or operators of bulk oils or liquid fuels terminals to obtain a certificate of financial responsibility from the Department of Environmental Quality.

HB 4121 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates statewide emergency preparedness offices and authorities to coordinate emergency management.

HB 4132 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Declares that it is the goal of the Legislative Assembly to fund the Department of Veterans' Affairs in an amount that is not less than \$10,000,000, from the General Fund, in 2015 dollars, adjusted for inflation.
