#### Work Session

HB 4038 Prohibits the Oregon Health Authority from taking enforcement actions against providers or payers under the Health Care Cost Growth Target program before January 1, 2036.

HB 4047 \*\* Requires the Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules and procedures to allow a hospital to apply for a license as a rural emergency hospital. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 4048 \*\* Expands the rural health care income tax credit to include pharmacist services performed in rural communities. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

HB 4053 \*\* Establishes the Emergency Medical Services Program Fund. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 4074 Directs a hospital to implement a hospital-wide nurse staffing plan that has been developed and adopted by the hospital nurse staffing committee or, if the committee has not adopted a plan, a hospital-wide nurse staffing plan that meets the statutory requirements.

HB 4075 Authorizes the State Treasurer to loan up to 20 percent of the Unclaimed Property and Estates Fund to rural hospitals for financial stabilization.

HB 4107 Requires an urgent care center to make publicly available specified information about the urgent care center, offer specified services and, except in certain circumstances, have at least one licensed health care provider on site during the hours of operation.

HB 4119 Requires for the certification of a managed care provider plan that the plan not discriminate against any willing provider within the geographical service area of the managed care organization.

**HB 4131**

Directs the State Board of Pharmacy to issue a license to operate a mobile pharmacy to a qualified applicant.

**HB 4142**

Expands the definition of "debilitating medical condition" for the medical use of marijuana.

**HB 4155 \*\***

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires certain health insurers, the Oregon Educators Benefit Board and the Public Employees' Benefit Board to cover fertility services and treatments.

**HB 4156 \*\***

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Modifies the requirements for Medicaid supplemental reimbursements paid to emergency medical services providers.

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
