SB 1507 A

Updates the connection date to the federal Internal Revenue Code and other provisions of federal tax law.

Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 4004 A

To be heard after 3:35 pm Provides that additional taxes otherwise imposed upon disqualification of land from certain forestland special assessment programs may not be collected if the disqualification is due to the suspension of reforestation requirements as a result of insects or disease.

Work Session

HB 4052

Creates a corporate excise tax credit for each of the first three years that a bank does business in this state.

HB 4148

Allows city and county services for which net local transient lodging tax revenue may be used to be provided either directly by the city or county or indirectly by a special district.
