Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 1530

Expands the crime of aggravated harassment to include threats concerning public officials in specified circumstances.

SB 1570 A

Prohibits a hospital from disclosing for purposes of law enforcement individually identifiable health information or information concerning a person's citizenship or immigration status unless disclosure is required by state or federal law or court order or for ensuring continuity of care.

SB 1587 A

Prohibits public bodies from disclosing personally identifiable information to a data broker unless the data broker attests that the information will not be sold or transferred to any entity that will use it to enforce federal immigration law.

SB 1594 A

Requires the Department of Justice to consult with the Office of Immigrant and Refugee Advancement when the department develops, reviews or updates model policies intended to limit immigration enforcement at public facilities.

SB 1571 A

Adds a definition of "nicotine" and expands the definition of "tobacco products."
