Public Hearing

- SB 1509 A
Establishes the qualifications of an elector of President and Vice President of the United States.
- SB 1515 A
Modifies provisions relating to petitions for compensation for wrongful conviction.
- SB 1516 A
Provides that standing pretrial release orders do not affect the authority of a magistrate to consider the primary and secondary release criteria when making a release decision.
- SB 1517 A
Provides that an operator may require a participant in a sport, fitness or recreational activity to release the operator for claims for ordinary negligence under certain circumstances.
- SB 1521 A
Prohibits cities and counties within the Portland MSA from enforcing requirements that developers provide affordable units in multiunit dwellings unless the city or county first calculates the developers' average expected losses due to providing affordable housing and the city or county offsets those losses.
- SB 1528 A
Expands drug manufacturer annual reporting requirements to include all patient assistance programs offered or funded by the manufacturer that provided assistance to consumers in this state in the previous calendar year.
- SB 1565
Increases snowmobile registration fees.
- SB 1575 A
Adds new requirements for obtaining an initial license to operate and maintain a hospice program.
- SB 1595
Requires a professional licensing board to publish specified guidance regarding licensure and ensure certain staff receive culturally responsive training not later than January 1, 2028.

Requires an electric utility to disclose to its customers the costs of storing nuclear waste produced by an energy facility in generating electricity.
