HB 4022 A

Establishes the Oregon Imagination Library Program to provide a free book each month to eligible children, encourage children to develop a love of reading and learning and improve school readiness, third-grade reading proficiency and high school graduation rates.

HB 4068

Modifies the definition of "transition aged youth residential treatment home" to include young adults between the ages of 17 and 25.

HB 4083 A

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to, no later than June 30, 2027, adopt a uniform process for credentialing behavioral health providers and select an existing electronic credentialing system.
