SB 1575

Adds new requirements for obtaining an initial license to operate and maintain a hospice program.

Allows for the provision of epinephrine in schools by methods other than injections.

SB 1570

Please note: SB 1570 is scheduled solely for the purpose of hearing testimony from the people who previously signed up to testify at the meeting on 02/04/2026.

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study protections in health care facilities.

SB 1598

Requires certain health benefit plans to provide coverage for preventive health services in accordance with federal rules in effect on June 30, 2025, and immunizations recommended by the Public Health Officer in the future.
