Background

SB 455 (2019)

- Amended existing statute and **added apprenticeship reporting requirements for community college capital construction projects** funded in part or in whole by **Article XI-G bond** proceeds for contracts with a cost of **\$8M or more**.

ORS 350.379

- Requires community colleges to **report annually on the amount of work performed by apprentices, women, and minority individuals** under qualified contracts.
- **Applies to** community college capital **projects** with qualified contracts **solicited, advertised or entered into on or after January 1, 2021**.

Background

- **Community colleges are not subject** to the **additional reporting** requirements that apply to public universities in **SB 1572** (2020).
- This report covers **six projects**:
 - 1. Lane Community College** Science, Math & Engineering Building Renovation
 - 2. Linn-Benton Community College** Agricultural Center
 - 3. Oregon Coast Community College** Oregon Coast Advanced Technology & Trades Center
 - 4. Tillamook Bay Community College** Healthcare Education Building
 - 5. Treasure Valley Community College** Nursing & Allied Health Professions Center
 - 6. Umpqua Community College** Medical Careers Hub & Welcome Center



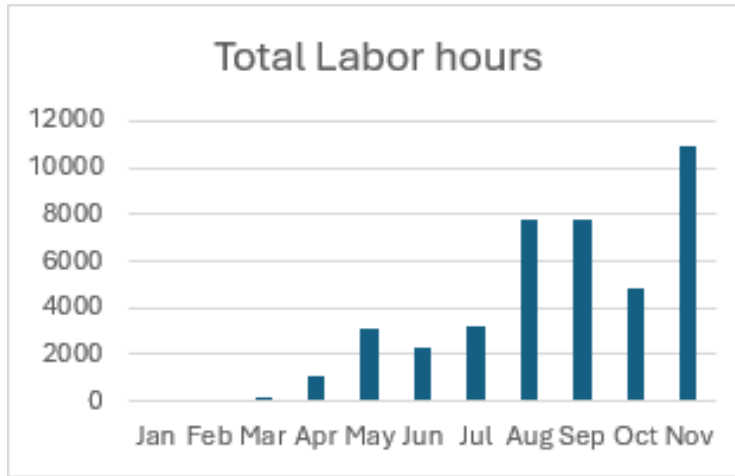
Science, Math & Engineering Building Renovation

Biennium Issued: 2023-25
 \$8 million in Article XI-G Bonds

The **\$31M** project will renovate the **89,547 ft²** facility to address **safety, accessibility, and deferred maintenance.**

- **Upgrade teaching laboratories** to current safety standards and educational pedagogies.
- **Improvements to the overall building infrastructure**, with emphasis on the HVAC systems and seismic resistance.

Agricultural Center

Biennium Issued: 2021-23

\$8 million in Article XI-G Bonds

The new **\$13.6M 2,343,905 ft²** complex supports the expansion of **high demand Agricultural Education** programs at LBCC's main campus in Albany.

- This new complex will house:
 - **Animal Science Classroom**
 - **Beef, Sheep, and Swine Barns**
 - **Arena and Paddocks**
- Phase 2 will house the **Horse Program**
- It will serve as a **hands-on experience** for **Veterinary Tech, Animal & Equine Science, Ag Business Management, Ag Tech, and Horse Management** programs

Oregon Coast Advanced Technology & Trades Center

Biennium Issued: 2023-25
\$8 million in Article XI-G Bonds

The **\$46.7M** project will construct a new **27,800ft²** trades education facility.

- Supports **pre-apprenticeship training** for county residents
- Expands **certificate and degree programs** in:
 - **Marine trades**
 - **Technical trades**
 - **Construction trades**
- Includes **campus-wide safety and facility improvements** to existing buildings

Healthcare Education Building

Biennium Issued: 2021-23
 \$8 million in Article XI-G Bonds

In 2022, voters in Tillamook County approved a \$14.4M bond to construct the **28,000 ft²** Healthcare Education Building. With **\$8M from the Oregon Legislature** and a \$1.4M bond premium, **\$23.8M** in bond dollars are available for this project.

- Houses **Nursing, Medical Assisting, EMT & Paramedic, Phlebotomy, and Limited X-ray Certification** programs.
- **360-seat Community Events** adaptable into three event spaces.
- Provides **local access to advanced healthcare training and equipment.**

Nursing & Allied Health Professions Center

Biennium Issued: 2021-23

\$4.95 million in Article XI-G Bonds

The **\$14.3M** project will construct a new **30,000 ft²** center to **expand and improve** the college’s top rated **nursing program** and **expand allied health programs** for its service area.

- The college has raised matching funds through several avenues, including a **Federal HRSA grant (\$3M)**, **private foundation**, and **donor grants**.
- Programs Housed: **Nursing (CNA, LPN, RN, BSN)**, **Medical Assistant, EMT, Surgical Tech**, with more programs in development.

Medical Careers Hub & Welcome Center

Biennium Issued: 2023-25
\$8 million in Article XI-G Bonds

The new **\$21.5M 23,604ft² welcoming service-focused space** will connect students to opportunities for their future **and meet the healthcare needs** of Douglas County.

Welcome Center will provide:

- One modern, centralized location for student access to and support of Admissions, Student Registration, Advising, Financial Services

Medical Careers Hub will provide:

- Industry partnerships
- In-demand High-skill, High-wage Medical Career Pathways and Programs
- Academic and Skills Learning with classrooms and simulation labs
