Dear Chair Taylor,

The Workers' Compensation Management-Labor Advisory Committee (MLAC) has been tasked with the review of SB 1519.

The committee understands that a broad coalition of stakeholders is working to ensure that the bill aligns with the recommendations presented by the MLAC Subcommittee on Average Weekly Wage as outlined below:

“The subcommittee recommends the proposal jointly brought forward from the management (AGC and OBI) and labor (AFSCME) stakeholders: increase the temporary disability rate from 66 2/3 to 75% of the injured worker's weekly wage, for the portion of wages below 75% of the state average weekly wage (SAWW), and 65% for any wages above 75% of the SAWW.”

The formal MLAC review process for the proposed bill is currently ongoing. A coalition of stakeholders that include: management, labor, insurer, plaintiff and workers' attorneys, who have already jointly submitted an amendment to address any concerns raised during our meeting last week. Once the amendment is finalized, MLAC will need to review the language to ensure it achieves the stated outcome and remains consistent with the recommendations of the subcommittee. We appreciate the collaborative nature of the process and the hard work and dedication of all the stakeholders in reaching a compromise and engaging in the process.
