### **Calculation of rent/cost burden**

~~Severely~~ cost/rent burdened

American Community Survey (ACS) five-year estimate data (United States Census Bureau)  
based on evidence available *at the time public notice is issued*



### **Non-developed internal tracts**

A tract disqualifies a city only if all of the following apply: larger than 20 net residential acres; contains no permanent buildings; is not adjacent to improved public utilities suitable for immediate connection; has no final land use entitlements or development approvals and consists of contiguous or near-contiguous parcels.



### **Treatment of resource land**

and adds a fourth category only if all of the following conditions are met: at least 80 percent of the land within one-quarter mile of the city's UGB is resource land; city received no qualified applications for urban reserves, nonresource land, or exception land during the application process; selected site ranks highest under the existing prioritization framework in ORS 197A.285.



### **Total acreage allowed**

Up to 170 net residential acres for cities population >25,000.

# DLCD grant making authority

- Clarity for long-standing practice of the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) issuing grants to local jurisdictions to implement land use system
- DLCD recently discovered that the authority was implied and not express
- Section 4 gives express authority to issue grants to DLCD, no impact on practice
- DLCD will continue to issue grants to local partners to implement the land use system
