Workers' Compensation Information System Modernization

On February 3rd, the Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee received a report from the Department of Consumer and Business Services on the Workers' Compensation Information System modernization project.

The Workers' Compensation Division of the Department of Consumer and Business Services established a modernization program to provide strategic leadership and oversight for process, system, and application improvements for the Workers' Compensation System.

The project received Stage Gate 1 and 2 endorsements, and the request for proposal was released in November 2025. There are currently 10 vendor proposals under review and evaluation and vendor selection is anticipated by fall 2026, with full implementation completed by June 2028. The agency will provide an update on the project timeline, projected cost, and anticipated ongoing maintenance and licensing costs to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means during the 2027 legislative session.
