Measure Description:

Increases snowmobile registration fees.

Revenue Impact:

The impact of this measure is likely to be \$107,000 for the 25-27 biennium, then \$240,000 per biennium after that.

Impact Explanation:

The measure increases snowmobile registration fees from \$10 to \$30. Although, collected by DMV, the revenue goes to the Snowmobile program, which is not part of the highway fund. However, its revenue is first used to cover DMV collection costs which seem to be exceeding collected revenue currently. DMV on average processes 6,000 snowmobile registration transactions per fiscal year. Registration fee increase would bring in additional \$120,000 in revenues per FY. Implementation (effective date) might not span the full 2027 fiscal year, the second year of the current biennium.
