Dear Chair Kropf, Vice-Chairs Andersen and Wallan, and Members of the Committee:

I am writing to you as the Executive Director of the CLEAR Clinic (a free legal services clinic in Oregon) in strong support of House Bill 4117. As a universal representation provider since the program's statewide inception, the CLEAR Clinic has seen firsthand how legal representation transforms lives, preserves families, and strengthens the fabric of our Oregon communities.

Since joining this statewide effort, the CLEAR Clinic has provided invaluable legal services to thousands of immigrant Oregonians through universal representation funding. Our nation's immigration system is notoriously complex and, unlike in criminal court, there is no right to a court-appointed attorney for those who cannot afford one. This system has often been referred to as deciding death penalty cases in a traffic court setting. Without the Universal Representation Fund, thousands of our most vulnerable neighbors and community members would be forced to face the enormously well-funded Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) prosecution efforts against them alone.

In addition to being the Executive Director of the CLEAR Clinic, I have been an immigration attorney since 2010. The current rate and brutality of ICE enforcement actions is truly unprecedented. Accordingly, Oregon's universal representation program has been stretched to an unmanageable degree. More than five times as many people have enrolled in the program over the past two years than in the two years prior, while funding remained stagnant. At the same time, our jobs as legal service providers have gotten exponentially more difficult under this federal administration. Often, the only way we can secure any semblance of due process for our clients is to take their claims to the federal courts. And because ICE is shipping Oregonians to private detention centers all over the country, this means we must get admitted to and teach ourselves to practice in new federal courts seemingly weekly. Accordingly, the universal representation program is expected to provide much more complex and difficult legal services, for nearly five times as many people, with the same level of funding we had last biennium.

HB 4117 will provide a critical additional \$10 million lifeline in funding to ensure that Oregon continues to be a national leader in protecting immigrant rights by providing access to counsel. For the CLEAR Clinic, this funding means:

- **Keeping Families Intact:** We represent parents, workers, and students who are deeply rooted in Oregon. When an individual has legal counsel, they are significantly more likely to succeed in their case, preventing the trauma of family separation.
- **Economic Stability:** Our clients are essential contributors to Oregon's workforce. Legal stability allows them to maintain employment, pay taxes, and support their local economies without the constant fear of arbitrary and unjust detention and removal.
- **Guaranteeing due process rights for all Oregonians:** Legal representation ensures that ICE actions are subject to judicial review and do not go unchecked, and that court proceedings are fair and cases are decided on their merits.

The demand for our services continues to outpace our resources. Every day, the CLEAR Clinic sees the anxiety of Oregonians who simply want their day in court. This bill is not just about providing immigration legal services, it is about the fundamental Oregon value that everyone deserves a fair chance, regardless of their income or where they were born.

We urge you to pass HB 4117 to ensure that Oregon remains a national leader in protecting the legal rights of immigrants and refugees. Thank you for your time and for your commitment to our communities.

My name is Ana Araujo and I live in Southeast Portland in House District 42. I am a parent of two PPS students, a former college instructor, and someone who cares deeply about our immigrant neighbors. I am writing in strong support of Universal Representation, HB 4117.

Violent, lawless ICE sweeps have targeted immigrants, our families, and communities here in Oregon, resulting in fear, anxiety, job loss, lowered school attendance for children, and devastating family separations. No family should have to plan for parents being torn from their children. It is imperative that Oregon respond in a unified manner to these attacks on our communities.

Universal Representation has already supported over 21,000 immigrant Oregonians. Demand has surged 4,000% since last year, especially since the rise in raids in fall 2025

I support HB 4117 because everyone has the right to due process and families belong together. Recently I have supported an asylum-seeking neighbor whose spouse, the family breadwinner, was detained. This person has a baby and has been left without any source of income and has had to scramble to make sense of our immigrations system while at the same time finding a way to keep a roof over their head and provide a secure home environment for their child This is wrong. Universal representation can assist families who are facing these challenges.

Although I was born in the U.S., I am the child of immigrants who became U.S. citizens decades ago, and while we thankfully are not the direct target of these current attacks, I can only imagine the level of emotional distress that many immigrant families are currently experiencing. Universal Representation has been a lifeline for these families. I know people in the broader Portland area are afraid to go to work, drop their kids off at school, or leave their homes. This is unjust and absurd and has had negative repercussions on the entire community – economic and otherwise. People across the Portland metro area are coming together to support our neighbors – running errands, handling bureaucratic tasks, accessing resources, assisting with school drop-offs and pick-ups, delivering food, and more. We care. Oregonians care about our immigrant neighbors. I have seen how the middle school students at my children's school have responded to the current situation with food and supply drives for their immigrant community members. Our children care deeply about what is happening to their fellow Oregon residents. If 11–14-year-old students can step up to care for immigrants, the adults need to do so too. When a breadwinner is detained, children need immediate support with food, rent, and utilities and we can help provide those resources.

Universal Representation is part of the 2026 Immigrant Justice Package and is backed by a broad coalition of immigrant justice advocates, unions, and community-based organizations. Over the past year, I have seen how everyday people have stepped up to care for their neighbors. I urge you to support these community-led policies to protect the freedoms of all Oregonians.

My name is Carla Gonzalez Pineda and I am the Executive Director of Pueblo Unido PDX, a nonprofit in Oregon that connects immigrants with vulnerable immigration status to legal, social, and Indigenous language interpretation services. Our organization has served as the statewide navigating organization for the Universal Representation program since 2019 and we have seen firsthand how impactful the program is for our families and communities. I am writing in strong support of Universal Representation, HB 4117.

Immigrant Oregonians have been targeted by an unprecedented level of surveillance, intimidation, and arrest by immigration officers, which has resulted in a sharp increase in the number of Oregonians detained for removal, and subsequently an increase in fear, anxiety, and demand for Universal Representation's services.

Universal Representation has already supported over 20,000 immigrant Oregonians, and demand has surged 4,000% since last year.

I support HB 4117 because legal representation is essential to ensuring due process and equitable access to justice for all Oregonians. Indeed, representation by an attorney is the single most determinative factor in deportation proceedings. Representation by an attorney improves a person's chances of staying with their family by 457 percent.

Pueblo Unido has navigated more than 5,500 people to the Universal Representation program, all of whom were unable to afford to pay \$10,000-\$15,000 to hire private legal representation. URep enables these Oregonians to access quality legal counsel, file applications on time, obtain work authorization, and pursue their right to remain in the US with their families.

Without URep, immigrant Oregonians who have fled violence, persecution, and extreme poverty, and who have a lawful right to remain in the country, would be forced to represent themselves before a hostile immigration court in proceedings that involve complex and ever-changing legal concepts, and that carry stakes as high as permanent banishment from the United States, family separation, and sometimes, life or death. Many of these Oregonians would likely be deported simply because they cannot afford to hire an attorney.

Universal Representation safeguards due process by allowing immigrant Oregonians to access the rights and protections afforded to them under existing law. It means the difference between family separation and unification; between marginalization and inclusion; and, for survivors of torture, political persecution, or discrimination due to their gender, sexuality, or identity, it means the difference between safety in the United States and a threat to their lives elsewhere. We must protect the rights of everyone who calls Oregon home and support their ability to thrive. By doing so, we can continue being a place that values healthy families, resilient communities, and human dignity.

Universal Representation is part of the 2026 Immigrant Justice Package and is backed by a broad coalition of immigrant justice advocates, unions, and community based organizations. I urge you to support these community-led policies to protect the freedoms of all Oregonians.

Oregon Food Bank’s mission is “to eliminate hunger and its root causes... *because no one should be hungry.*” Here’s the reality we face: hunger in Oregon is already at crisis-levels, but this will continue to worsen as immigrants are deprived of basic needs, and face intimidation, deportation, and family separation.

The families we serve are terrified– terrified to go to work, terrified to go to school, terrified to find food to feed their families. **Families should never feel that seeking food is more dangerous than forgoing food.** We call on Oregon leaders to protect Oregonians who are under attack and fully fund HB 4117, Universal Representation. This bill provides critical legal services for immigrants, as well as direct assistance for families who have been separated.

HB 4117 Assists Families and Children Separated From A Detained Parent.

When a parent is detained, their child needs immediate support to stay fed and housed– on top of the trauma of separation. HB 4117 provides direct assistance to families with children who have been separated from their caregiver and breadwinner to help with food costs, housing costs, utility payments, and more.

HB 4117 Ensures Universal Representation Continues To Support Families.

Breaking families apart means a weaker, more food insecure Oregon– one where more Oregonians face instability at home and at work. Case by case, Universal Representation successfully keeps Oregon families together, and has already supported over 20,000 immigrant Oregonians.

Oregonians are being detained at unprecedented levels, which is why demand for Universal Representation over the past year has surged by 4,000%. Oregon lawmakers must invest \$10m in order to allow this critical program to continue keeping Oregonians stable and secure.

Universal Representation is part of the 2026 Immigrant Justice Package and is backed by a broad coalition of immigrant justice advocates, civil liberties groups, unions, and community based organizations. We urge you to rise to this moment and support these community-led policies to protect the freedoms of all Oregonians.

Chair Kropf and members of the House Judiciary Committee, my name is Cristian Mendoza Ruvalcaba. I am a nurse practitioner from Medford and a member of the Oregon Nurses Association. In addition to being a member, I sit on our Cabinet on Health Policy. Although I am an employee of OHSU, this is a personal opinion and does not represent the opinion of OHSU. I am here in support of sustained funding for the Universal Representation program.

As a nurse practitioner, I have had the honor of caring for people from diverse backgrounds, regardless of immigration status. Nursing ethics obligates us to care for everyone with dignity and compassion.

Everyone, regardless of immigration status, deserves the same dignity and compassion in the judicial system.

Legal representation is often the difference between an immigrant exercising their rights and accepting an unfair outcome, between an asylum seeker finding refuge or returning to a life-threatening situation, and between a family with mixed status staying together and being split apart.

Immigrants who are represented in removal proceedings are fifteen times more likely to apply for relief and five-and-a-half times more likely to win their cases and prevail against unjust deportations when compared to their non-represented counterparts. ¹

Oregonians deserve continued access to legal representation, just as they deserve access to health care—especially at a time when members of our communities and our neighbors are being targeted because of the color of their skin, the language they speak, or the work they perform.

My name is Kaleb Lay and I'm director of policy & research with Oregon Rural Action. ORA is a community-led nonprofit in northeast Oregon, one of the most diverse and economically productive regions in Oregon. Oregon's immigrants are our workers, our family, our friends, our neighbors, our classmates, and our colleagues, and they are part of what makes Oregon strong and beautiful. ORA strongly supports HB 4117.

Immigrant families need our support. This bill will make critical investments that provide direct assistance to kids in Oregon and protect their due process and civil rights. It would invest \$5M to provide immigration legal services in Oregon, and \$5M to the Children's Stability Fund, which provides direct services to children who are separated from a caregiver.

These resources are essential in northeast Oregon and statewide, especially as federal immigration officials continue their efforts to disrupt, threaten, and intimidate our families, communities and workforce.

This bill will keep Oregonian families together. Tens of thousands of Oregonian children with U.S. citizenship status live with an undocumented family member, and thousands more Oregonian children are immigrants themselves. This bill would ensure that those children and their families have access to basic legal representation and provide support for rent, utilities, and food when breadwinners are detained.

This bill will keep Oregonian workers working. Around one-in-eight workers in Oregon are immigrants. Both the state's economy and our local economy in northeast Oregon rely heavily on immigrants, many of whom are underpaid and rely on the legal services this bill would support.

As federal immigration officials continue to infringe on our individual rights and liberties, HB 4117 will make a sensible, meaningful investment in protecting Oregonians. We urge your full support for the bill.

My name is Bridget Cooke, I am the Executive Director and Co-founder of Adelante Mujeres. Our services here in Washington County build a stronger community for everyone.

I am writing in support of HB 4117 - Universal Representation and Children's Stability Fund, one of the bills in the Immigrant Justice Package.

Regardless of how often ICE says that their actions are protecting public safety, we know that what we are seeing today has nothing to do with safety. Rather, it is an effort to roll back decades of advances in civil rights. **The vision of a vibrant, pluralistic, multi-faith, and multi-racial community scares the Trump administration, and inspires vicious behavior.**

I applaud your efforts to stop the racial profiling, and the horrific tactics of ICE. HB 4117 is essential to these efforts. We cannot allow Homeland Security to act with impunity.

Adelante Mujeres is a non-profit organization in Washington County with a rich history of engaging Latine immigrants. Adelante Mujeres' mission is to provide holistic education and empowerment opportunities to low-income Latina women and their families to ensure full participation and active leadership in the community. Our organization served over 15,000 individuals in 2025 with comprehensive and life-changing services that span from Education, Microenterprise training, Health Equity, and Leadership programs.

Adelante Mujeres' legal clinic provides immigration legal services and is a Universal Representation navigator, serving immigrant families in Washington County and beyond.

A friend of ours was recently picked up by ICE. His attorney was able to obtain a habeas petition to secure his release. So now, rather than being in ICE detention, he is free. This happened because of Universal Representation. The attorney acted with lightning speed before our friend was transported out of Oregon. He was actually on an ICE bus on his way to the Tacoma Detention Center, but still in Oregon, when the judge granted the petition, and the bus turned around. That's the difference ten minutes makes in someone's life. This ability to respond on the spot depends on funding for U.Rep.

The other part of HB 4117 is the Children's Stability Fund. We are immensely grateful to our local jurisdictions, the cities of Forest Grove, Cornelius and Hillsboro and Washington County for finding funds to help the community. **We now also need our State to provide funding for the community.**

Universal Representation is backed by a broad coalition of immigrant justice advocates, unions, and community-based organizations. I urge you to support these community-led policies to protect the freedom of all Oregonians.

My name is Alma, and I have lived in Washington County for over 20 years. I am a mother of three children, I work in this county, and I do my shopping and live my daily life right here. My family and I are active members of this community.

I am writing this testimony to express my support for the Universal Representation proposal, HB 4117, because it is an urgent need for our community.

Unfortunately, for more than a year, the community has been targeted by violent and illegal raids by ICE, simply because of their skin color, which has caused deep and constant fear. These actions have severely affected children, young people, and adults, sowing terror in our communities.

My children, who are U.S. citizens, are afraid to go to school and to come home. They live with the fear of not finding their father or me when they return, for fear of an arrest. This situation is affecting them emotionally and also in their school performance. Although they were born in this country, they feel that their own country is failing them by allowing growing hatred and racism towards their parents and towards people who look like them.

In previous years, my children had clear goals: to study, to excel, and to become responsible individuals. That is what we have taught them as parents. Today, that enthusiasm has been replaced by fear. They are no longer only worried about learning, but about the safety of their family and their community.

Immigrants are hardworking people; we contribute every day to making Oregon a stronger, more humane, and beautiful place. We are a community that cares for and protects one another. No one deserves to live with constant fear, mental stress, or the fear of being arrested, beaten, or harmed. Many people are no longer going to work for fear of being detained, which leaves them even more vulnerable, unable to pay rent, buy food, or cover their families' basic needs. Our community does not deserve to live this way.

The HB 417 proposal would bring real and necessary benefits.

If this proposal is approved, families will receive legal support during extremely difficult times, when they need it most. People will not have to face such a complex and frightening legal process alone.

For our children and young people, this would mean an alleviated peace of mind and hope. Knowing that their parents have the support of a lawyer would give them security, allow them to focus on their studies, and feel supported by the system that should protect them .

Furthermore, I am part of a non-profit organization “Adelante Mujeres”, and every day we receive calls from desperate families seeking legal aid, support from lawyers, and mental health services. Unfortunately, we do not have sufficient funds to meet the enormous need that exists.

For all these reasons, I respectfully ask you to support the HB 4117 proposal. Legal representation is vital to protect working families and to defend the dignity and human rights of our community.

Dear Chair Kropf, Vice-Chairs Chotzen and Wallan, and Members of the House Judiciary committee,

My name is Rebecca Battin, and I am the Director of Policy and Legal Services at Pacific Refugee Support Group (PRSG). PRSG supports immigrant Oregonians with wrap-around supportive services, including wellness, education, housing, career pathways, legal services, and more. We support all immigrant Oregonians who have been forcibly displaced and help them navigate a path to a safe, fulfilling life in their new home.

Our work has become much more challenging and even more important over the past year, since the attacks on immigrant Oregonians have escalated dramatically. Perhaps most notable is the staggering increase in extralegal ICE data theft, private property trespass and damage, arrests, detentions, and deportations. All of these, often illegal, actions have left communities all across the state shaken beyond measure. Our community members are terrified to leave their homes to get groceries, go to work, go to required court appointments, and even take their children to school. ICE's actions have hurt all of Oregon's communities by separating families and leaving holes and fear in our workplaces, schools, hospitals, places of worship, and more.

In the face of this immense and growing systematic attack on our immigrant community, we need to invest in strengthening our response.

Luckily, Oregonians and the legislature have already acted to create a program that is best suited to respond to this large-scale threat. The Universal Representation program, or ECO, is an amazing, genuinely life-changing program for so many community members across Oregon. The program has **already served 21,000 people** and our community already knows and trusts ECO to support them in our collective fight against these unlawful sweeps and detentions.

I, personally, along with other PRSG staff and many other people from community-based organizations across the state, provide trusted, economically efficient, and essential legal representation and advocacy to our immigrant community through the Universal Representation program. The program helps eligible community members with so many essential immigration legal matters. My organization regularly helps people apply for and receive legal work authorization, which supports Oregon's economy

and increases tax revenue.



Universal Representation also funds attorneys who work around the clock to advocate for Oregonians illegally arrested and detained by ICE. This service has obviously become one of the most essential aspects of the program in the past year and is so incredibly important to our community that it cannot be overstated.

I met a young mother last Thursday, who came into our office for help to apply for asylum. Her husband was scheduled to come with her, but he had just a couple days before been taken early in the morning by ICE when he went to get groceries for his family. They stopped him in his car and took him. She and her children were heartbroken and terrified. There is no way to remedy the pain she feels from suddenly, senselessly, and illegally losing her husband to masked men without names or a warrant or a word, even. My name is Debbie Cabrales. I am the Executive Director of Centro de Servicios Para Campesinos, and I live in and represent the community of Woodburn, Oregon—a predominantly Latinx community. I write today in strong and urgent support of Universal Representation, HB 4117.

At Centro de Servicios Para Campesinos, we were able to enroll her in the Universal Representation program, connect her with an attorney, drive her to her court hearing, and ensure she had someone by her side in the courtroom. For the first time in months, she felt seen. She felt supported. She felt that someone believed her family was worth fighting for.

The gratitude in her children's eyes is something I will never forget.

Without Universal Representation, we would have had to turn her away like so many others had. Instead, we were able to offer dignity, stability, and hope at one of the most frightening moments of her life.

Every day, families like hers walk through our doors terrified. Children are afraid to go to school because they worry they will return to an empty home. When a parent is detained, families are suddenly left scrambling to cover rent, buy groceries, and keep the lights on. The emotional and economic toll ripples across entire communities.

Founded in 1977, Centro de Servicios Para Campesinos has worked for nearly five decades to improve the quality of life for immigrants and farmworkers. These services are not luxuries, they are lifelines. They are entry points to economic stability, health security, and community safety for some of Oregon's most vulnerable workers.

Hello Chair and Members of the Judiciary Committee,

My name is Blayne Soleymani-Pearson, and I am writing as a volunteer with the Hillsboro United Mutual Aid Network (HUMAN). I am testifying today in support of HB 4117.

HUMAN was created in response to the immigration crisis our community is facing. A group of caring, committed Hillsboro residents came together to support immigrant and refugee families impacted by recent ICE/CBP/DHS enforcement actions. While we began as a Hillsboro-focused effort, the need quickly expanded, and we now support families across Washington County.

Since our inception in October 2025, HUMAN has provided groceries to more than 500 families, helped keep 15 families housed, and distributed over \$9,000 in direct aid through grassroots, community-powered efforts.

We are proud of what we have accomplished, but I want to be honest about the challenges. Our organization is entirely volunteer-run. Many of us are putting in 20 to 30 hours a week—on top of full-time jobs and family responsibilities, delivering groceries, collecting donations, coordinating housing support, and raising funds for rental assistance. This work is emotionally heavy. Volunteers experience burnout and secondary trauma from being on the front lines with families who are scared, grieving, or suddenly without a breadwinner.

We want to support every family affected by ICE actions, but the reality is that our capacity is limited. We cannot meet every need. We cannot replace a lost income. We cannot provide long-term stability. And it is heartbreaking to know that families are falling through the cracks simply because community volunteers cannot stretch any further.

Our story is just one example of what mutual aid groups across the region have been facing for months. Community members are doing everything they can—but we are not a substitute for state-level support.

This is where HB 4117 becomes essential. The proposed \$5 million would go a long way toward helping immigrant families who have been separated, destabilized, or left without a primary wage earner due to detainment. Cities within Washington County—and the county itself—have already declared states of emergency and allocated local funds. But local governments cannot shoulder this alone. It is time for the state to step in and provide meaningful relief.

These families are not criminals. Their racial or ethnic identity does not make them criminals. What many of them are experiencing is unjust, and while there may be disagreement about how to address the harm of federal immigration enforcement, one thing we can agree on is that Oregon families deserve stability, dignity, and support in moments of crisis.

Providing financial relief is a concrete, immediate step the state can take to prevent homelessness, hunger, and long-term harm. HB 4117 is an opportunity to show our immigrant communities that Oregon sees them, values them, and will not abandon them.

For these reasons, I strongly support HB 4117 and ask you to vote yes for this bill. Thank you for your time and consideration.
