**Bill Title:** Relating to public meetings; prescribing an effective date.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:** Special Districts, Statewide - Executive Branch, Statewide - Judicial Branch, Statewide - Legislative Branch, Cities, Government Ethics Commission, Counties

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure revises Oregon's public meetings law by clarifying public body responsibilities for notice and meeting requirements, modifying restrictions on serial communications and expanding communications not considered meetings. The measure also revises grievance procedures, allowing public bodies to rescind actions, acknowledge violations within 90 days or correct procedures to ensure future compliance.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the next committee.
