Here are my challenges to the final investigation report dated 2/2/2026:

Challenge 1:

V. Findings – 8.

Co-chair McClain: “We’ll carry this into another room. So thank you very much, both of you, for your comments. That’s enough.”

We did not continue to another room or meeting space. In fact, Representative McLain did not speak to me for several months after the adjournment of this meeting. In addition, it is of note that the Senate President was at the dais as a member of the committee and should have said something, stopped the meeting, and dealt with the situation. He did not. This is an important fact to include into the record that he allowed this to occur with no immediate action.

Challenge 2:

V. Findings in general

The report findings in this section include Rep Gamba's comments correctly. What is missing from this section is Representative Kevin Mannix's comments from the same committee hearing. Rep Mannix used the word "grossly" in reference to the proposal, describing it as "grossly obese." Rep Mannix was commenting on the size and scope of the proposed transportation funding package, which involved significant tax and fee increases to generate billions of dollars. This omission certainly should be found as an error in the report.

Certainly, this should be included in the report as it shows multiple men's comments - of which I used the same words as both Rep Gamba and Rep Mannix - and how neither of them (notably one a Republican, and one a Democrat) were shut down, berated and/or interrupted.
