

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 4115

Relating to Health Care Providers

HB 4115 extends the period during which the Oregon Health Authority and the Department of Human Services can complete a criminal records check from 18 months to 3 years and limits the agencies' ability to require a new criminal records check in the interim period.

The measure directs coordinated care organizations to reimburse for behavioral health services retroactively to the date the behavioral health provider submitted a request to the Oregon Health Authority for enrollment in the state medical assistance program.

The bill has a minimal fiscal impact on the agencies and an indeterminate fiscal impact on the Oregon State Police due to an assumed decrease in revenue resulting from the extension of the period between required background checks.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 4115 be reported out do pass.
