Subject: HB 4033 – Relating to emergency volunteers  
Work Session Recommendations

The measure requires the duties, function and powers of the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) relating to the Oregon Volunteers in Disaster database (ORVID), be transferred to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management (ODEM). ORVID is Oregon's statewide online disaster volunteer database used to connect and manage volunteers before, during, and after disasters and emergencies. The system has historically been managed by the OregonServes Commission under HECC, and the measure makes this transfer to ODEM to more appropriately align the work associated with the system to the agency most directly associated with its use.

The -A2 amendment adds \$32,600 General Fund for the subscription cost of the system for the remainder of the 2025-27 biennium.
