Measure Description

The measure appropriates \$900,000 General Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD) in the 2025-27 biennium, for planning and technical assistance to four specified industrial symbiosis pilot communities (COR Healthy Communities, Clatsop County, Klamath County, and the Port of Morrow). The measure directs OBDD to develop an industrial symbiosis roadmap for the purpose of promoting voluntary industrial symbiosis activities in Oregon; and establishes the required elements of the roadmap and Oregon's industrial symbiosis goals. OBDD must provide a report on the industrial symbiosis roadmap to the Legislature.

Fiscal Analysis

Oregon Business Development Department

The fiscal impact for OBDD is estimated to be \$1.2 million General Fund in the 2025-27 biennium, and there is no fiscal impact in the 2027-29 biennium. The measure appropriates \$900,000 General Fund for contracted technical assistance to four specified communities to facilitate, plan, and design industrial symbiosis projects. Project management, procurement, contract management, and fund disbursement can be managed with existing resources. However, OBDD will require an additional \$250,000 General Fund in the 2025-27 biennium for a professional services contract to develop the industrial symbiosis roadmap, based on the cost of contracts for similar projects.

Other entities

There is no fiscal impact for counties.

Relevant Dates

The measure takes effect on the 91st day after sine die.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Measure: HB 4086 - A5

OBDD is to select, by August 31, 2026, an organization or service provider with expertise and documented experience in industrial symbiosis planning to provide the technical assistance described in the measure.

OBDD is to submit a report on the industrial symbiosis roadmap to the Legislature by May 1, 2027.

Sections 1 and 2 of the measure both sunset on January 2, 2029.
