

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 4033

Relating to emergency volunteers

HB 4033 requires the transfer of the Oregon Volunteers in Disaster database, also known as ORVID, from the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management.

ORVID is Oregon's statewide online disaster volunteer database used to connect and manage volunteers before, during, and after disasters and emergencies. The oversight of this system is being transferred to better align the activities of the program with the agency that directly oversees disaster and emergency events.

The –A2 amendment adds \$32,600 General Fund to cover system subscription costs for the remainder of the 2025-27 biennium.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends HB 4033 be amended by the –A2 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
