

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 1601

Program Change

SB 1601 is a non-appropriation measure that makes necessary changes in statutes and session law to support the 2025-27 legislatively adopted budget, clarify the application of statutes for the budget, and modify provisions relating to the use of funds. Specifically, the measure includes the following:

- Extends the deadline for the Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to complete Sex Offender Notification Leveling determinations to June 30, 2030;
- Modifies statutes related to pay frequency in anticipation of the transition to two-week pay periods;
- Adds testing for PCB exposure to the allowable uses of the Healthy School Facilities Fund;
- Transfers \$23 million from the State Information Technology Operating Fund and \$29.7 million from the Oregon Infrastructure Finance Fund to the General Fund;
- Transfers \$48 million from specified transportation funds to support operations and maintenance;
- Redirects \$170 million dedicated for other transportation-related uses to support operations and maintenance; and

- Removes the statutory cap on lottery transfers to the County Fair Account beginning July 1, 2027, allowing the full 1% of lottery revenues to be transferred annually.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 1601 be amended by the –3 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
