**Measure Description:**

Authorizes the Governor to direct state agencies to withhold moneys owed to the federal government if federal funds are being withheld from the state in contravention of a valid court order.

**Revenue Impact:** See impact explanation.

**Impact Explanation:**

The measure provides the Governor, with the consent of the Attorney General and State Treasurer, the authority to withhold qualified payments from the federal government but does not require it. The measure makes no changes to state tax policy. However, the measure requires any monies remaining in the Federal Moneys Holding Account as of January 2, 2037, to be transferred to the General Fund. This transfer could result in additional General Fund revenue at that time.
