SUMMARY

Digest: Changes some laws about contempt of court. The Act changes some laws about surrogacy contracts. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.8).

Modifies provisions relating to contempt proceedings.

Modifies provisions relating to the confidentiality of surrogacy agreements.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure changes the confidentiality provisions for surrogacy agreements. It makes all records of cases for determination of parentage of a child born by assisted reproduction under a gestational surrogacy agreement confidential and exempt from disclosure under the public records laws, with limited exceptions, but does not require the court to seal these records.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could gain information related to court cases for the determination of parentage of a child born by assisted reproduction under a gestational surrogacy agreement.
