SUMMARY

Digest: Amends the Constitution to say that there is a right to be free from enforcement of the law by secret police. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.6).

Proposes an amendment to the Oregon Constitution establishing a right to be free from enforcement of the law by secret police.

Refers the proposed amendment to the people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election.
