SUMMARY

Digest: The Act makes a commission on AI to look at the state's use of AI. The Act also tells DAS to hire a person to make a privacy, data protection and AI plan for the state. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.4).

Establishes the Senator Aaron Woods Commission on Artificial Intelligence within the office of Enterprise Information Services. Directs the commission to identify and report on long-term policy implications in the use of artificial intelligence technologies by the state. Directs the commission to submit an annual report to the Legislative Assembly. Allows the commission to make recommendations for legislation, regulations or policy to the Legislative Assembly.

Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to hire an individual responsible for developing the state's strategic vision related to privacy, data protection and artificial intelligence. Allows the department to charge a state agency, officer, board or commission for services provided by the department or the Senator Aaron Woods Commission on Artificial Intelligence.
