

House Bill 4050

Sponsored by Representative MCINTIRE (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells LPRO to conduct a study on funding for education. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.3). Requires the Legislative Policy and Research Director to study processes to align educational funding with educational costs. Directs the director to submit a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than November 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1 Relating to funding for education; and declaring an emergency.

2 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

3 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Legislative Policy and Research Director shall study processes by
4 which other states of the United States and provinces of Canada attempt to align state or
5 provincial distributions of educational funding to local educational providers with the edu-
6 cational costs of the local educational providers.

7 (2) The director shall submit a report to the interim committees of the Legislative As-
8 sembly related to education no later than November 15, 2026.

9 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this 2026 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.

10 **SECTION 3.** This 2026 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
11 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2026 Act takes effect
12 on its passage.
