SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives funds to DAS to put in the Universal Representation Fund. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.4).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for purposes of deposit in the Universal Representation Fund.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to universal representation; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium ending June 30, 2027, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$10,000,000, for deposit in the Universal Representation Fund established under ORS 9.865 and disbursement to Oregon Worker Relief as the fiscal agent under ORS 9.865.

SECTION 2. This 2026 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2026 Act takes effect on its passage.
