

# Senate Bill 1544

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Transportation)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that ODOT must study speed bumps. (Flesch Readability Score: 94.3).  
Requires the Department of Transportation to study the development of uniform standards for speed bump height and markings.  
Sunsets January 2, 2028.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transportation.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4       **SECTION 1.** (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study of speed bumps  
5 to examine the possibility of developing uniform standards for speed bump height and speed  
6 bump markings and shall make a report on its findings.

7       (2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and  
8 may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative  
9 Assembly related to transportation in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than  
10 September 15, 2027.

11       **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this 2026 Act is repealed on January 2, 2028.
