

Senate Concurrent Resolution 207

Sponsored by Senator WAGNER (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Fixes firm dates for measures during session. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.7).

Establishes deadlines and procedural rules for completion of legislative measures for the 2026 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

(1) This resolution constitutes a rule of proceeding of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly.

(2) The Senate and the House of Representatives shall adhere to the following schedule and deadlines for the 2026 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly:

(a) The Senate and the House of Representatives shall convene in regular session on February 2, 2026.

(b) Committee chairpersons shall schedule work sessions for measures in the chamber of origin no later than February 9, 2026. This paragraph does not apply to:

(A) The Joint Committee on Ways and Means;

(B) Other joint committees except for the Joint Committee on Transportation, Joint Committee on Transportation Funding and Joint Committee on Transportation Oversight; and

(C) The Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue, House Committee on Revenue, Senate Committee on Rules, House Committee on Rules, Senate Committee on Conduct and House Committee on Conduct.

(c) Committees shall consider measures in the chamber of origin no later than February 16, 2026. This paragraph does not apply to:

(A) The Joint Committee on Ways and Means;

(B) Other joint committees except for the Joint Committee on Transportation, Joint Committee on Transportation Funding and Joint Committee on Transportation Oversight; and

(C) The Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue, House Committee on Revenue, Senate Committee on Rules, House Committee on Rules, Senate Committee on Conduct and House Committee on Conduct.

(d) Committee chairpersons shall schedule work sessions for measures in the second chamber no later than February 20, 2026. This paragraph does not apply to:

(A) The Joint Committee on Ways and Means;

(B) Other joint committees except for the Joint Committee on Transportation, the Joint Committee on Transportation Funding and the Joint Committee on Transportation Oversight; and

(C) The Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue, House Committee on Revenue, Senate

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
