**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 4057**

1      On page 4 of the printed bill, delete lines 3 through 29 and insert:

3      **“REPORT ON STREAMLINING EDUCATION BACKGROUND CHECKS**

5      **“SECTION 3. (1) The Department of Education, in consultation with**  
6      **the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission, the Department of**  
7      **Early Learning and Care and the Department of State Police, shall:**

8      **“(a) Develop recommendations to allow individuals who are enrolled**  
9      **in the Central Background Registry established under ORS 329A.030 to**  
10     **automatically satisfy any background check requirement under the**  
11     **jurisdiction of the Department of Education or the Teacher Standards**  
12     **and Practices Commission, including an analysis of any legal, opera-**  
13     **tional, technological, privacy, financial or other relevant consider-**  
14     **ations.**

15     **“(b) Analyze the similarities and differences among background**  
16     **check requirements for individuals subject to the jurisdiction of the**  
17     **Department of Education, the Teacher Standards and Practices Com-**  
18     **mission and the Department of Early Learning and Care.**

19     **“(c) Analyze how federal law, including the Child Care and Devel-**  
20     **opment Block Grant Act of 2014 and any federal regulations adopted**  
21     **under the Act, applies to and constrains the authority of the state in**

1 developing recommendations under paragraph (a) of this subsection.

2       “(2) The recommendations under this section must comply with  
3 public records law, ORS 192.311 to 192.478 and federal law, including the  
4 Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 2014 and any federal  
5 regulations adopted under the Act.

6       “(3) The Department of Education, in consultation with the Teacher  
7 Standards and Practices Commission, the Department of Early  
8 Learning and Care and the Department of State Police, shall submit  
9 a report on the subjects described in subsection (1) of this section in  
10 the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and shall include recommen-  
11 dations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative  
12 Assembly related to education and early learning and care no later  
13 than November 15, 2026.”.
