**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4055**

- 1 On page 2 of the printed bill, line 5, delete “48” and insert “24”.
- 2 Delete lines 13 and 14 and insert:
 - 3 “(b) The State Chief Information Officer shall prescribe:
 - 4 “(A) The format in which a report must be submitted under this section.
 - 5 “(B) The standards for notifying and reporting under this section. The
 - 6 standards must align to the greatest extent practicable with nationally re-
 - 7 cognized standards or frameworks, including standards or frameworks for
 - 8 incident classification, reporting and secure methods and protocols for the
 - 9 transmission of information.”.
- 10 After line 32, insert:
 - 11 “(B) The Oregon Department of Emergency Management;”.
 - 12 In line 33, delete “(B)” and insert “(C)”.
 - 13 In line 34, delete “(C)” and insert “(D)”.
 - 14 In line 42, delete “and”.
 - 15 In line 44, delete the period and insert “; and
 - 16 “(c) Any follow-up information or updates a public body should provide
 - 17 following an initial notification.”.
- 18 On page 3, after line 12, insert:
 - 19 “(7)(a) A notification or report provided by a public body pursuant to
 - 20 subsection (2) of this section does not relieve the public body from the duty
 - 21 to give notice of a breach of security under ORS 646A.604 or any other notice

1 required by state law.

2 “(b) The State Chief Information Officer and the Attorney General:

3 “(A) Shall coordinate to minimize costs to public bodies to comply with
4 subsection (2) of this section and ORS 646A.604, and any duplicative notifi-
5 cation or reporting requirements; and

6 “(B) May allow for a single notice or report that allows a public body to
7 meet the requirements under subsection (2) of this section and ORS
8 646A.604.”.
