**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 4069**

- 1      On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 18 through 30.
- 2      On page 2, delete lines 1 through 3 and insert:
  - 3      “(c) ‘Lone worker’ means an individual who directly provides or assists  
4      with the delivery of behavioral health services and works in a situation or  
5      location without a colleague nearby or without close or direct supervision.
  - 6      “(2) A behavioral health employer shall:
    - 7      “(a) Implement a written policy or plan for the physical safety of indi-  
8      viduals working for the behavioral health employer.
    - 9      “(b) Provide a copy of the safety policy or plan to new workers upon hire.
  - 10     “(3) A safety policy or plan required under this section must:
    - 11     “(a) Include a plan for addressing the physical safety of lone workers.
    - 12     “(b) Include a plan for the safety of the built environment, including:
      - 13     “(A) How workers may report structural security hazards; and
      - 14     “(B) The time frame within which the behavioral health employer must  
15     respond to a report of a structural security hazard.
    - 16     “(c) Include information for workers about the safety training that the  
17     behavioral health employer is required to provide under ORS 430.775, in-  
18     cluding the time frame within which the employer must provide all required  
19     training for a new worker and how often the employer must provide renewal  
20     training for current workers.
  - 21     “(d) Be tailored to the behavioral health employer’s specific context.

1       “(e) Be easily accessible to staff.”.

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
