**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 4007**

- 1      On page 1 of the printed bill, line 4, after the semicolon delete “and”.
- 2      In line 5, after “814.600” insert “; and prescribing an effective date”.
- 3      On page 18, line 34, delete “26” and insert “26a”.
- 4      On page 19, after line 44, insert:  
**“SECTION 29. Section 30 of this 2026 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 267.**
- 5      **“SECTION 30. Restrictions on financing for districts formed under ORS 267.107.** (1) As used in this section, ‘mass transit district’ means a district that was formed by a resolution pursuant to ORS 267.107.  
6      **“(2) A mass transit district may not use any method of financing under ORS 267.300 other than a method of financing authorized to be used under ORS 267.300 (1)(b) or (h) to (j) without first obtaining authorization at a properly called election held for that purpose.**  
7      **“(3) If a mass transit district has adopted an ordinance under ORS 267.300 (1)(a) or (c) to (g) on or after January 1, 2026, and before the effective date of this 2026 Act, the ordinance is suspended until after the ordinance is approved by the electors of the mass transit district at a properly called election held for that purpose.”.**
- 8      On page 20, line 3, delete “29” and insert “31”.
- 9      After line 5, insert:

## **“OPERATIVE AND EFFECTIVE DATES**

**“SECTION 32. Sections 1 to 4, 18 to 20 and 26a to 28 of this 2026 Act, the amendments to ORS 153.633, 153.645, 153.650, 153.660, 646.608, 801.348, 3.030, 803.305, 806.020, 807.020, 811.050, 811.440, 814.484, 814.486, 814.489, 4.512, 815.052 and 815.281 by sections 5 to 16 and 21 to 26 of this 2026 Act and the repeal of ORS 814.485, 814.487, 814.488, 814.534 and 814.600 by section 17 of this 2026 Act become operative on January 1, 2027.**

**“SECTION 33.** This 2026 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2026 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”.
