**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1571**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “adults;” insert “creating new
2 provisions;” and after “180.441,” insert “180.448,”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 40 and 41.

4 On page 3, delete lines 6 and 7.

5 In line 8, restore “(4)” and delete “(5)”.

6 Delete lines 14 through 30 and insert:

7 **“SECTION 2. ORS 180.441 is amended to read:**

8 **“180.441. (1) As used in this section:**

9 **“(a) ‘Cigar’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 323.500.**

10 **“(b) ‘Local government’ has the meaning given that term in ORS**
11 **174.116.**

12 **“(c) ‘Premises’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 431A.190.**

13 **“(d) ‘Tobacco products’ has the meaning given that term in ORS**
14 **431A.175.**

15 “[~~(1)(a)~~] **(2)(a)** A person engaged in the business of selling cigarettes,
16 inhalant delivery systems [*or*], smokeless tobacco products **or tobacco pro-**
17 **ducts** for profit may not ship or transport, or cause to be shipped or trans-
18 ported, cigarettes, inhalant delivery systems [*or*], smokeless tobacco products
19 **or tobacco products** ordered or purchased by mail or telephone or through
20 a computer or other electronic network to any person in this state other than
21 a distributor or retailer.

1 “(b) Paragraph (a) of this subsection does not apply to a freight forwarder
2 or motor carrier, as those terms are defined in 49 U.S.C. 13102, as in effect
3 on August 8, 2017, or an air carrier, as defined in 49 U.S.C. 40102, as in effect
4 on August 8, 2017.

5 “[2)] **(3)** A retailer may not sell cigarettes, inhalant delivery systems
6 [or], smokeless tobacco products **or tobacco products** unless the retailer or
7 an employee of the retailer makes the sale to the purchaser in person as part
8 of a face-to-face exchange **on premises licensed under ORS 431A.198 or**
9 **an ordinance, rule or resolution adopted by a local government with**
10 **jurisdiction over the premises.**

11 “[3)] **(4)** A person may not knowingly provide substantial assistance to
12 a person that is violating subsection [(1) or (2)] **(2) or (3)** of this section.

13 **“(5) Subsections (2) and (3) of this section do not apply to the sale,**
14 **shipping or transport of cigars.”.**

15 On page 4, after line 41, insert:

16 **“SECTION 3a.** ORS 180.448 is amended to read:

17 “180.448. (1) If it appears to the Attorney General that a person, including
18 a person described in ORS 180.441 [(1)(b)] **(2)(b)**, has possession, custody or
19 control of any information, document or other material that is relevant to
20 an investigation of a violation of ORS 180.400 to 180.455 or 323.806, or that
21 could lead to the discovery of relevant information in an investigation of a
22 violation of ORS 180.400 to 180.455 or 323.806, the Attorney General may
23 execute an investigative demand and may cause an investigative demand to
24 be served upon the person. The investigative demand may require the person:

25 “(a) To appear and testify under oath at the time and place stated in the
26 investigative demand;

27 “(b) To answer written interrogatories; or

28 “(c) To produce relevant documentary material or physical evidence for
29 examination at the time and place stated in the investigative demand.

30 “(2) An investigative demand under this section shall be served in the

1 manner provided by ORS 646.622 and may be enforced in the manner provided
2 by ORS 646.626.

3 “(3) As used in this section, ‘person’ does not include a participating
4 manufacturer as defined in ORS 180.405.”.
