**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1517**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 17, delete “and” and insert
2 “now, therefore,”.

3 Delete line 18.

4 On page 2, line 7, after “guiding,” insert “environmental restoration and
5 maintenance,”.

6 Delete lines 9 through 41 and insert:

7 “(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, an operator may
8 require a participant in a sport, fitness or recreational activity who is 18
9 years of age or older, or a parent or guardian on behalf of a participant in
10 a sport, fitness or recreational activity who is under 18 years of age, to re-
11 lease the operator from any claim for ordinary negligence that arises out of
12 or results from a person’s participation in a sport, fitness or recreational
13 activity, rental of equipment for a sport, fitness or recreational activity, use
14 of a facility or place for a sport, fitness or recreational activity or volun-
15 teering to maintain facilities or places used for sport, fitness or recreational
16 activity, if the participant or parent or guardian voluntarily agrees in writ-
17 ing to a release that clearly and unambiguously discloses the primary risks
18 associated with the sport, fitness or recreational activity and warns the
19 participant that the sport, fitness or recreational activity involves potential
20 hazards. A release described in this subsection is not per se unconscionable
21 or void as contrary to public policy.

1 “(3) An operator may not require a participant or a parent or guardian
2 to release the operator from claims for greater than ordinary negligence,
3 including claims for gross negligence, reckless conduct, willful misconduct
4 or intentional acts.”.
