**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4145**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “amending” delete  
2 the rest of the line and delete lines 3 and 4 and insert “sections 10 and 13,  
3 chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2023; and declaring an emergency.”.

4 Delete lines 6 through 14 and delete pages 2 through 28 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1. Section 10, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2023, as amended by  
6 section 6, chapter 594, Oregon Laws 2025, is amended to read:**

7 **“Sec. 10. ORS 166.503, 166.505 and 166.508 and the amendments to ORS  
8 166.412, 166.435, 166.436 and 166.438 by sections 6 to 9, chapter 1, Oregon  
9 Laws 2023, apply to firearm transfers conducted on or after [*March 15,*  
10 *2026*] **January 1, 2028.****

11 **“SECTION 2. Section 13, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2023, as amended by  
12 section 7, chapter 594, Oregon Laws 2025, is amended to read:**

13 **“Sec. 13. The provisions of ORS 166.355 apply to the manufacture,  
14 importation, possession, use, purchase, sale or transfer of a large-capacity  
15 magazine occurring on or after [*March 15, 2026*] **January 1, 2028.****

16 **“SECTION 3. The Legislative Assembly does not intend this 2026  
17 Act to render moot or otherwise affect any proceedings pending before  
18 the Oregon Supreme Court concerning the constitutionality of Ballot  
19 Measure 114 (2022), and the court has authority to issue a judgment  
20 on the issue of the constitutionality of Ballot Measure 114 (2022) not-  
21 withstanding any amendments to chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2023, by this**

1 **2026 Act.**

2 **“SECTION 4. This 2026 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
3 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
4 **declared to exist, and this 2026 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
