**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1517**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 3 through 18.

2 Delete lines 20 through 22 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,**
4 **a release of liability executed by a person 18 years of age or older, or**
5 **by a parent or guardian on behalf of a person under 18 years of age,**
6 **before the person engages in a recreational activity is enforceable as**
7 **a matter of law and is not unconscionable or contrary to public policy.**

8 **“(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to releases of li-**
9 **ability for:**

10 **“(a) Willful or wanton acts or omissions, reckless acts or omissions**
11 **or grossly negligent acts or omissions.**

12 **“(b) Negligent hiring claims for injuries sustained as a result of an**
13 **act constituting a crime under Oregon law.**

14 **“SECTION 2. This 2026 Act being necessary for the immediate**
15 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
16 **declared to exist, and this 2026 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
