Measure 114 is already a terrible idea. It is clearly unconstitutional, both based on Oregon's constitution, as well, as the US constitution, and this kind of firearm restriction is not in-line with the text of either constitution, nor the history and tradition of Oregon or the United States in general. This bill takes an already bad idea and seeks to punish law-abiding gun owners even more than the original measure. I say "bad idea" because even if measure 114 was errantly found to be constitutional (it's not), the passage of this bill would only impact law-abiding gun owners, and not the criminals you say you want to stop.
