I'm strongly opposed to the consolidation of the power to decide to who in the country is able to purchase or own firearms. The process for disbarment from gun ownership should be checked and appealable, and subject to the decision of a fair, unbiased group of individuals who represent only the interests of their individual opinions. Any other process of an effective judicial decision may be found undemocratic at best and authoritarian at the worst. Measure 114 is an example of the continued erosion of the rights promised to American citizens in the founding and supporting laws of this land. I personally believe in the monitor and restriction of firearms sales in the interest of keeping firearms away from dangerous individuals. I do not believe Measure 114 works in this interest, and that it in fact works against law abiding Oregonians.
