I may want to remind you that M 414 has not been decided upon. Also what part of "shall not be infringed upon" do you not understand! Permit issue from authorities goes from 30 days to 60 days. The fee going from \$65 to \$150.

The cave out for LEO has to be a violation of civilian rights, declaring Standard magazines "weapons of war" as there is a clause in Oregon's Constitution specifically notes in Section 20.
