My name is Jamie Hernandez, and I am writing as a private citizen to respectfully oppose House Bill 4088.

I come to you not as a lawyer or a politician, but as a human being guided by faith and conscience. To the God of eyes—the God who sees every life before it ever takes a breath—abortion is a sin. I believe that with my whole heart.

I believe every life has meaning, purpose, and dignity, even when it is small, unseen, or inconvenient. When I think about abortion, I do not see a political issue. I see a life that will never get the chance to open its eyes, to feel love, or to find its place in this world. That reality weighs heavily on my soul.

I understand that people come to this issue with different experiences and beliefs. I do not speak from hatred or judgment, but from deep sorrow and conviction. I believe we should be offering compassion, support, and real alternatives—not policies that make it easier to end a life.

I ask you to consider the lives that cannot speak for themselves. I ask you to consider that there is a higher accountability than public opinion or political pressure. To the God who sees all, every life matters.

For these reasons, I respectfully urge you to oppose HB 4088.
