I oppose these changes because they add additional permitting and administrative burdens on lawful firearm owners without addressing the root causes of violent crime. Measure 114 has already created confusion, delays, and unequal access to a constitutional right depending on county resources and processing times. I believe efforts should focus on enforcing existing laws and addressing criminal misuse, not placing new barriers on law-abiding citizens.
